On an extremely dry and windy day the Warwick Selling Agents ,on behalf of their clients offered 1371 head of livestock to the trade. Lambs today topped at \$200 to average \$138.53, hoggets topped at \$134 to average \$84.58, ewes topped at \$94 to average \$55.32, wethers topped at \$80 to average \$75.03, Ram lambs topped at \$140 to average \$91.43. The yarding was drawn from the Central and Southern Downs , with a few New England and South Western consignments rounding out the offering. The trend was slightly dearer for the better finished lambs. The lambs with good cover and falling into the 18kg to 24kg dressed weight range were keenly sought after. The howling and dry winds did little to help the re- stocker market with those lighter lambs lacking finish falling in value compared to previous sales. Mutton again lacked the fire-power of the earlier months with the values coming back to more equitable prices with over the hooks.
