The BIG DRY and all it means to both primary producer and hobby farmer, was brought to life today as Agents yarded 3004 head of livestock to the assembled buying panel. A couple of the usual buyers were limited in their purchases and this has seen the market come back to basics. The better type lambs are still in good demand but buyers are able to source from various ways to keep the numbers flowing. As this report is processed there are a few showers in the local and Southern border areas which may bring some relief. The major problem with a lot of growers is the availability of water. The lambs today topped at \$169 to average \$126.13 this is mainly due to good light lambs being at a premium, hoggets topped at \$151 to average \$98.03. Mutton was a slower story with the top ewes making \$94 to average \$64.83, wethers didn't fare any better with tops at \$92 to average \$66.57. there were a few larger consignments from the central Maranoa area as they launch into a strong period of little or no rainfall and it is the lack of feed and water leading to the larger yardings.
