Agents today had their hands full again as 3753 head of livestock came to the weekly sale. Lambs today were fully firm on the last weeks rate with better lambs in a firmer circle in some instances. Lambs topped today at \$171 to average \$110.70(a \$12 increase on last week), hoggets topped at \$120 averaging \$68.95 the same as the previous sale, ewes topped at \$98 to average \$49.57 up on last week, wethers topped at \$100 to average \$54.69 the same a last week. There were a few larger consignments from the local vendors as well as he usual drawing areas of the Maranoa and Western Downs. The only change to the saleyard dynamics are the increase of hobby and small producers offloading their breeders both male and female. This will have an impact as we move into the latter months with shortfalls to be a concern to both vendors and consumers.
