

# McDougall and Sons Pty Ltd Sheep & Lamb Report

12/8/2020



Agents only yarded 487 head to meet the local buying panel. Exporters whilst in attendance could not commit to purchases with those low numbers. The lambs of better quality and finish were in stronger demand as well as light feed on stock. Lambs topped at \$183 to average [\\$151.33](#) (\$17 up), hoggets topped at \$137 to average [\\$120.11](#) (\$8 down), ewes topped at \$160 to average [\\$107.47](#) (\$8 down), wethers topped at \$140 to average \$83.11 (\$65 down). The main lines were in lambs and hence the larger variation in the mutton types. As with all markets the numbers game will come into play particularly as we don't have access to the normal outlets as restaurant and smaller food outlets struggle with the lockdown and covid restrictions.
