## Sheep and Lamb Report 28/10/2020

Agents today yarded a rain affected number of 702 head for the weekly sale. The lamb and hogget numbers were only 50% of the yarding as we saw a flashback to the markets of the 1980s and 90s when mutton was the major contributing factor in the Warwick saleyards. Again one of the volume buyers was not in attendance , but the local buyers kept the rates at reasonable levels. Lambs topped at \$197 to average  $\frac{168.89}{500}$ , hoggets topped at \$220 to average  $\frac{167.06}{140}$ , ewes topped at \$170 to average 90.87, wethers topped at \$180 to average  $\frac{154.04}{90}$ , ram lambs topped at \$150(\$4up).

The yarding of lambs was not dominated by ewe lambs as in previous weeks; hence the prices were up and down according to the finish and yield rather than the ability to go back to the paddock and reproduce. Mutton was fully firm with a few pens of heavy shorn wethers and rams returning good rates.
