Sheep and Lamb Report 24/3/2021

Wet, wet, wet, that was the theme of the Sheep & Lamb today at Warwick as floodwaters tended to threaten the supply chain. Sheep and Lamb numbers looked like being beaten by the number of buyers at the sale at one stage but rallied to have 270 head. Lambs topped at \$230 to average $\frac{174.50}{par}$, ewes topped at \$224 to average $\frac{197.08}{174.50}$, wethers topped at \$161 (\$10up).

The usual panel of buyers and exporters were flat to fill orders with most of the ewe and lamb portion finding homes back to the paddock.
